18h Hill, 3524 SD

A group of adventurers faced off against the final exam of the adventurer's guild, in this case fighting a massive Girillon. The battle was quick (and particularly painful for at least one of the heroes), and while they did pass, several members decided to take on more cowardly risk-averse roles instead; leaving Flynn, Gondra, and Toro as the final hangers-on. While they were able to achieve their primary objective and quickly escape, they lost Plonk and Spewns; the latter of whom used his dying breath (and a near-unintelligible accent) to entrust Araki with returning his hammer. Upon returning through the portal to the study of Mo'kra Willowwind, the team were dismayed to learn that the item that they had sacrificed so much to get was just a trinket left after a hurried breakup.

19h Hill, 3524 SD

Dismayed (and potentially psychologically scarred), the remaining team returned to the guild house where they were assigned to work with the remaining graduates. The next mission: To help Mycologist Isolde Nightshade investigate rumors of a "garbage eating mushroom". After a somewhat-restless night, the newly forged team set out to find Isolde; which was no easy task, as she lived in "The Bins", a town out in the garbage desert called the Ramshackle Wastes.

After reaching her and doing only a little bit of partying, Isolde pointed them toward the "Endless Slaughter", an area of the wastes that was subject to demonic invasion. They went that way and eventually found the mushrooms, by harvesting them out of a large and angry demon and his friends.

What Did We Learn?
