These adventures within a shared universe of settings describes associations of unlikely heroes who band together for a common cause. For some, they explore the unknown in search of answers. Others are in it only for the riches. Many are driven by destiny. As a group, they are known as the "Well Met Heroes." This is their story.

Calledras "Callie" Shadowblade, Kishin, Lucille, Seraphina Underhill, Shenzaiah Oneiros, Wren, and "Splurt!" began their journey toward adventuring fame in the city of Kognombia by taking their Adventurer's Guild exams. They made short work of their final examination and officially became Class D adventurers. After some deliberation on which quest to take, they decided upon collecting the soul contract of one Peter Fineas. They quickly found their way through Lower Downtown Kognmobia (LoDoToKoGno) until they reached the offices of Litiguron et al. After suffering a fairly standard wait time in an infernal lobby, they met with Advocate-Devil Litiguron himself, who gave them the details - Peter Fineas was a warlock-turned-paladin who reneged on a deal to pursue a relationship with another deity. Litiguron needed a magical sword returned, and if possible Peter's head.

The "heroes" were given a location through a vision, showing Peter hard at work besmirching Litiguron's good name by being a generally decent fellow. Having none of this, the group of "heroes" dashed immediately to Peter's location, where he was coaxing an animal from a tree. Recognizing that this animal may in fact be "Tiddles", which was the subject of another potential quest, Splurt decided to try double-dipping to complete two quests at once by taunting said animal. The animal that did indeed turn out to be tiddles had none of this, and pounced; quickly splatting Splurt. A bloody battle ensued, eventually Tiddles was subdued, and Peter was

brought to "justice". The party, not wanting to remove his head, decided to just carry the body and sword together via magic to deliver the whole package to Litiguron.

What did we learn?

- Most adventurers don't make it
- The "Brooding Stranger" has 40 unique shady corners. Perfect for clandestine meetings!
- Lawyers are the worst
- Morality is a matter of perspective
- Bad things happen to good people
- Stay out of the road
